Do-It-Yourself Collection

The law library has a collection of books written specifically for the non-attorney litigant. A list of these titles can be accessed using the library catalog searching with the keyword: self-help.

Formbook Collection

Included in the text collection are books that contain **sample forms**. These forms can be adapted by the user to suit the user's situation. Many of the formbooks provide forms in word processing format that can be accessed on library computers.

Maryland Collection

Includes Maryland case law, the Maryland Code, Maryland Rules of Procedure, Maryland regulations (COMAR), the Maryland Law Encyclopedia and a collection of texts on Maryland Law.

United States Collection
